

Club Overview

The Lower Hutt Tennis Club has four artificial grass and six plexipave courts. It is situated in Woburn, at 67a Totara Crescent. It is nestled on a reserve in the centre of a residential block. All four artificial grass and four plexipave courts are floodlit.

There is a clubroom, and a separate coaching building on site.

The club supports five Regional and five Senior Interclub teams. There is a very active Social Senior league competition that is run throughout the whole year on a Monday and Wednesday evening. There is also a very active mid-week club playing on Wednesday mornings.

The club offers coaching and interclub for the junior players for all grades from beginners (5-6yrs) to Intermediates (15-18yrs). There are currently twenty-one junior Interclub teams in the local competition, and two teams in the regional competition.

Lower Hutt Tennis club is seeking an individual coach or tennis operator with a proven track record to manage and deliver the coaching and competition programme for our club.

There is enormous potential for the right person as the committee is keen to develop extensive and varied coaching for its members at Lower Hutt Tennis Club.

The successful applicant will be required to deliver a tennis programme for the club including the following:

- A comprehensive competition programme for juniors and adults.
- Offer individual and squad coaching sessions.

The successful individual coach or tennis operator must have the following:

- At least three years experience of tennis delivery, and coaching
- Appropriate coaching qualification
- Good communication skills with ability to inspire players
- Enthusiastic and self-motivated
- Willing to learn and adapt to the running of any new programme
- Strong administration and organisation skills
- Ability to deliver high quality coaching sessions to players of all abilities and ages
- A willingness to promote tennis in the community
- Contribute to the club newsletter on a monthly basis.

The Club supports the Tennis NZ initiative of a grasshoppers programme for juniors. We would expect the successful applicant to continue/support this initiative.
