ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA	1. You must still be inside your chosen age group on April 30 <sup>th</sup> 2010 e.g. 12 or younger for the 12's age group on April 30 <sup>th</sup> , 2010. 2. Entry is open to all players who meet the age criteria. 3. <b><u>Players may enter one age group only. Doubles age group must be the same as singles age group entered.</u></b>
ENTRY DUE DATE	Entries <b><u>for all age groups</u></b> with correct payment must be received at the Tennis Central office no later than <b><u>5.00pm</u></b> on <b><u>Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> March.</u></b>

SURFACE	Synpave  <b>Games will be scheduled on both indoor and outdoor courts.</b>
DRAWS & REPORTING TIMES	Player reporting times and the draws will be available on the the tournament website by 5.00pm Wednesday 31 <sup>st</sup> March.
PLAY COMMENCEMENT	Play will commence at 08.30am each day or earlier if directed. Players must play under lights if required. Please note that play can go into the early evening for some, i.e after 6pm.

SIGN IN	Please sign in at the tournament office upon arrival to the courts each day.
RESULTS	The Slazenger Wellington Junior Open will be run on Tournament Planner and results will be recorded on Top Dog.
PLAYER CODE	Top Dog player code must be supplied on the entry form. If you do not have or do not know your player code please contact your Association for a code before submitting your entry form.
SEEDING	Seeding for all events will be at the discretion of the tournament organizers but will generally be based on the latest available Top Dog rankings at the time of the draw being made.
MATCH FORMAT	<p><b><u>Weather Permitting</u></b></p> <p><b>Singles</b> - All main draw singles matches are to be the best of three tiebreak sets with a conventional 12 point tiebreak at six games all, except for the 10's age group which will play the first to nine games.</p> <p><b>Doubles</b> – 12/14/16/18's age group doubles matches are to be the best of two tiebreak sets with "no ad" deuces and a conventional 12 point tiebreak at six games all. If sets are tied an 18 point "super" tie break will be played to determine the winner of the match. (Super Tie Break – 1<sup>st</sup> to 10 points with a margin of 2). 10's age group will play the first to nine games.</p> <p><i>(Tournament Officials have the right to alter the length of matches if circumstances deem it necessary).</i></p>
MATCHES	Players are guaranteed at least four matches, if player entered in both singles and doubles, with at least two of those matches being singles (weather permitting).
SCHEDULING	Tournament matches will not be scheduled around other engagements a player may have unless there are extenuating circumstances and Tennis Central have been consulted.
WITHDRAWALS	<p>Players who inform Tennis Central of their need to withdraw on or before 28<sup>th</sup> March will be entitled to a refund of the entry fee minus a \$5.00 admin fee. Players who inform Tennis Central of their need to withdraw after this date and before the tournament commences will be entitled to a refund of the entry fee minus a \$10.00 admin fee.</p> <p>For defaults and retirements the Tennis NZ Player Code of Conduct ruling will apply.</p>
WEATHER	Players must report to the courts irrespective of weather conditions unless advised to the contrary.
DRESS CODE	All players shall dress and present themselves in an appropriate manner for tennis. Clean and customarily acceptable tennis attire shall be worn during practice and competition. The referee in consultation with the tournament management has the final decision if the clothing worn is appropriate. Please refer to Tennis NZ Player Handbook or Players Code of Conduct for further clarification.
RULES	The tournament will be played in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of Tennis NZ, Rules of Tennis and Tennis NZ Player Code of Conduct. These are available from the offices of Tennis NZ on request.
PLAYER BEHAVIOUR	Tennis NZ Player Code of Conduct will apply.
ADJUDICATION	All players must be prepared to adjudicate when asked too (excludes beginners). All players must be able to self umpire.
